Instructions for tourists using their own vehicles or rental vehicles

Welcome to Tunisia

Tunisia is a beautiful country and travel by car is a great way to explore its many sights and attractions. Whether you are planning to travel on your own or with family and friends, you and your fellow travellers must follow the safety instructions below:

- Do not enter closed military zones in the bordering areas with Algeria, in the governorates of Jendouba, Kef and Kasserine.
- Do not enter the buffer border zone in the south of Tunisia without prior authorization.
- Contact regional tourism offices to obtain any information concerning these zones and the required procedures to get access authorizations for the desert.
- Coordinate with security services and inform them about your visits, scheduled trips and camping locations using GPRS. Providing this information will assist an emergency service response in the unlikely event they are required.
- Make sure you have your identity and vehicle documents and present them to security officers if needed.
- Don't enter any prohibited or sensitive security areas or take photographs when not allowed i.e. military barracks or police stations.
- When visiting coastal areas, only choose beaches that vacationers go to and with lifeguards.
